### When you give \$2.50 a week for one year, your donation provides:

- 20 hours of tutoring for a child at risk of academic failure.  
(Spirit of Excellence Program, Black Child Development)
- a comfort kit containing hygiene items for a disaster client.  
(Disaster Services, American Red Cross - Greensboro Chapter)
- 60 bus rides for individuals looking for employment.  
(Center of Hope Crisis Assistance Program, Salvation Army)

### When you give \$15 a week for one year, your donation provides:

- 8 counseling sessions for families to enhance their financial self-sufficiency  
(Consumer Credit Counseling Services of Greater Greensboro, Family Services of the Piedmont)
- 24 sessions to educate young men about pregnancy prevention.  
(Wise Guys/Jovenes Sabios, Children's Home Society of North Carolina)
- 2 days of medication administration and supervision for residents with physical disabilities.  
(Adult Care Home, Bell House, Inc.)

### When you give \$5 a week for one year, your donation provides:

- 1 week of preservation services to keep an at-risk child in their own home.  
(Family Preservation, Youth Focus)
- child care assistance for 2 women while they complete the pre-employment training series.  
(New Choices Program, Women's Resource Center)
- production of an adoption video to help a child find a forever family.  
(Adoption and Foster Care Services, Children's Home Society of North Carolina)

### When you give \$25 a week for one year, your donation provides:

- 20 screenings and classes to teach adults with low literacy to monitor their blood pressure.  
(Health Literacy, Reading Connections, Inc.)
- a four-day college tour for 5 low-income students  
(Black and Latino Achievers, YMCA of Greensboro)
- 18 hours of intensive case management services for individuals with HIV/AIDS.  
(Direct Client Services, Triad Health Project)

### When you give \$10 a week for one year, your donation provides:

- case management to help two at-risk students graduate from high school.

- 4 months of Mobile Meals for a homebound older adult.
